- Measure, monitor, review and continuously improve our IMS and workplace to achieve a high level of compliance with ISO 45001.

- Provide a safe premises and place of work.
- Provide employees with safe and adequate equipment.
- Provide employees with appropriate HSE related training, instruction, supervision, and assistance to fulfil their designated responsibilities.
- Provide PPE to employees that require it.
- Support managers in carrying out regular risk assessments of the areas and activities under their management.
- Eliminate identified hazards and reduce OH&S risks.
- Establish and maintain effective communication and consultation mechanisms with employees to facilitate valuable employee contribution, participation, cooperation, and commitment to our IMS.
- Maintain compliance with legal or other requirements.
